

Construction Update

Groundwater Monitoring Well Installation Beginning Mid-January 2011

Some residents of Abrams Park may see workers and equipment in areas near their homes mid-January.

WHY? The Army will be installing two groundwater wells as part of the on-going groundwater cleanup at the former Fort Ord. The location of the two wells is shown on the map on the reverse side. The well construction activities will take about 2 weeks. The wells will be used to monitor the groundwater. Typical well construction equipment is shown in the photo at the right.



YOUR WATER IS SAFE: The groundwater in this area is not used for drinking water. Your drinking water is supplied by the Marina Coast Water District from a different source area. Drinking water quality is very important and it is regularly tested by the Marina Coast Water District. Your drinking water meets all federal and state standards for safety.

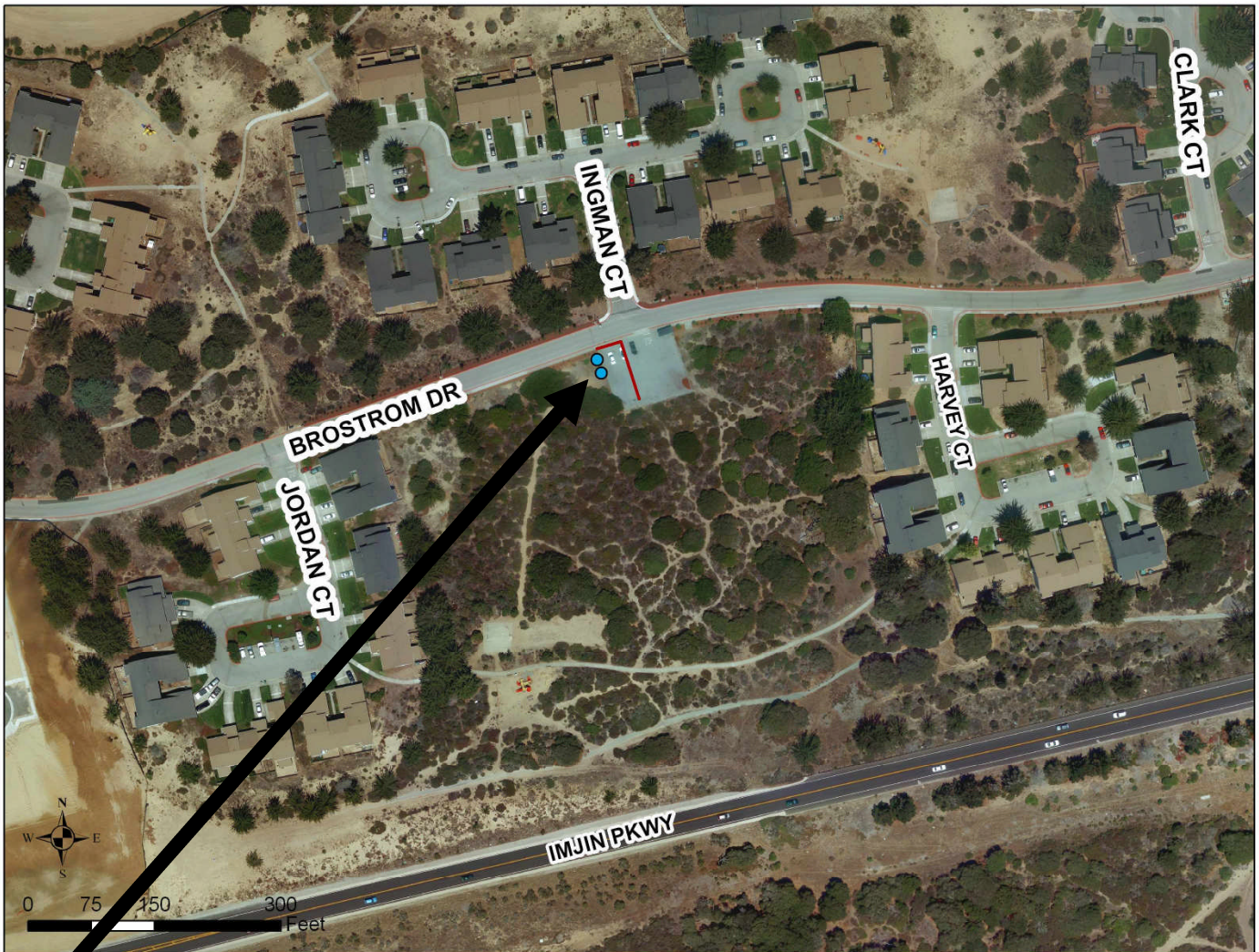
