

Upcoming Construction Activities – January 2005

Water Sampling and Treatment Well Installations

Residents of Fredrick Park I in the vicinity of Saratoga Court and Bunker Hill Road will be seeing construction workers and equipment in their neighborhood in January. Why? The new wells are being installed to extract and sample groundwater.

WHAT YOU MIGHT

SEE: A mud rotary drill rig (pictured at right) will be used to construct these wells. You may also see large metal bins parked on Bunker Hill Road. These will be used to hold the extra soil that results from drilling. Please take extra care when driving on Bunker Hill Road.



YOUR WATER IS SAFE: Water quality is very important and it is regularly tested by the Marina Coast Water District according to strict federal and state standards. The groundwater being investigated in this area is **not** used for drinking water.

There will be more construction activities in this area this winter as we construct a pipeline that connects one of these wells to a groundwater treatment plant.
