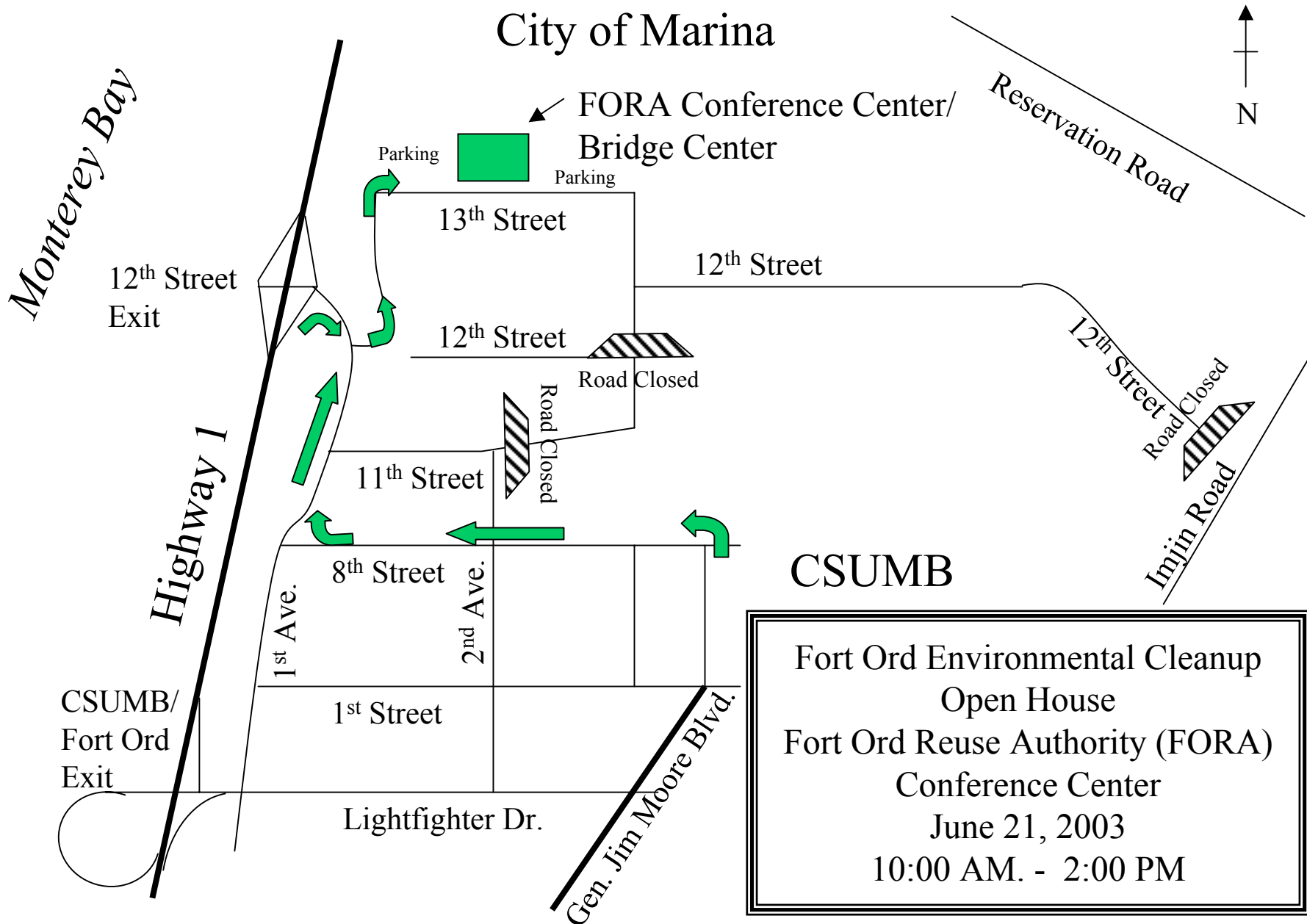
Come join us for tours, demonstrations, and displays as well as refreshments.
