

Upcoming Construction Activities – March/April 2006

Water Well Installation

Residents of California State University at Monterey Bay's Fredrick Park II in the vicinity of Saratoga and Bunker Hill roads will be seeing construction workers and equipment in their neighborhood in March and April. Why? The Army is drilling an additional well and collecting samples to further investigate the groundwater this area. A mud rotary drill rig (picture on the right) will be used to construct these wells. This is a continuation of the well drilling and pipeline construction that happened in December 2005.



The groundwater being investigated in this area is not used for drinking water. The water supplied to the homes in Fredrick Park II is safe to drink and use for all home activities. Water quality is very important and it is regularly tested by the Marina Coast Water District according to strict federal and state standards.

After the well is drilled, there will be more construction activities in this area as we install a pipeline that connects this new well to a groundwater treatment plant. A large metal bin will be parked on Bunker Hill Road. It will be used to hold mud from well drilling operations. Please take care when driving on Bunker Hill Road.
