Community Relations Plan 2005 Changes

- Update of actions since 2001
- Coordination with Fort Ord Community Advisory Group
- Coordination with Environmental Protection Agency's Technical Assistance Grant – Fort Ord Environmental Justice Network
- Greater emphasis on email and web



Listening to the Community

- Collected 200 surveys
 - Email, www.FortOrdCleanup.com
 - Events: County Fair, CSUMB list server and welcome fair
 - Sent to 52,000 households
 - Timeframe January - September 2005
- Completed 11 interviews
 - Stakeholders, Community Leaders, and Government Agencies
 - On-going
- It doesn't stop! Continual monitoring
