Superfund Proposed Plan - No Action For Selected Areas of Fort Ord

The Army Proposes No Action for Selected Areas at Fort Ord

The U.S. Army will hold a public meeting to discuss the Proposed Plan for No Action for Selected Areas of Fort Ord, CA. The Proposed Plan identifies areas that contain no evidence of ordnance and explosives (OE) and have never been suspected as having been used for OE-related activities of any kind. The Proposed Plan also describes a plug-in process for other areas that may be eligible for No Action status in the future after additional research.

The public comment period for the Proposed Plan begins February 4, 2000 and ends March 5, 2000. Written comments to the Proposed Plan, postmarked no later than March 5, 2000, should be sent to:
