Draft Final Operable Unit 2 Well Installation Work Plan, Former Fort Ord, California This Work Plan describes the methods and procedures to be used for installation of monitoring wells associated with the presence of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in the groundwater at the former Fort Ord, California. This Work Plan is for installation of five A-Aquifer monitoring wells and three 180-Foot Aquifer monitoring wells. The Work Plan describes the proposed well locations, construction details, geologic logging, development, and sampling. In addition, this Work Plan describes the methods that will be employed to complete the project, the project organization, and other applicable project criteria.

2010 FONR Impact Assessment and Rare Plant Species Survey Results, Operable Unit 1, Fritzsche Army Airfield Fire Drill Area, Former Fort Ord, California This document provides the results of the rare plant surveys conducted at Operable Unit 1 (OU1) during 2010. In accordance with the recommendation in the 2009 annual impact report, the third year of rare plant monitoring in the roadways where pipelines were constructed in 2007 was not

warranted. The OU1 rare plant surveys conducted during 2010 were, therefore, limited to the survey conducted in a reference plot located outside the OU1 boundary and observations made by UCSC staff during weed control activities.
