Draft Well Destruction Report, Operable Unit 1, Fritzsche Army Airfield Fire Drill Area, Former Fort Ord, California As a result of the groundwater cleanup process through June 2011 and the effectiveness of the current remediation system, many wells once needed for groundwater extraction/monitoring were no longer necessary. To protect groundwater quality and eliminate potential pathways for illegal waste disposal, Monterey County Environmental Health Department regulations require that such wells be sealed and destroyed. Consequently, 55 wells within Operable Unit 1 that were no longer needed for extraction or monitoring purposes were sealed and destroyed in September 2011. This secondary deliverable documents the field activities associated with destruction of these 55 wells.
