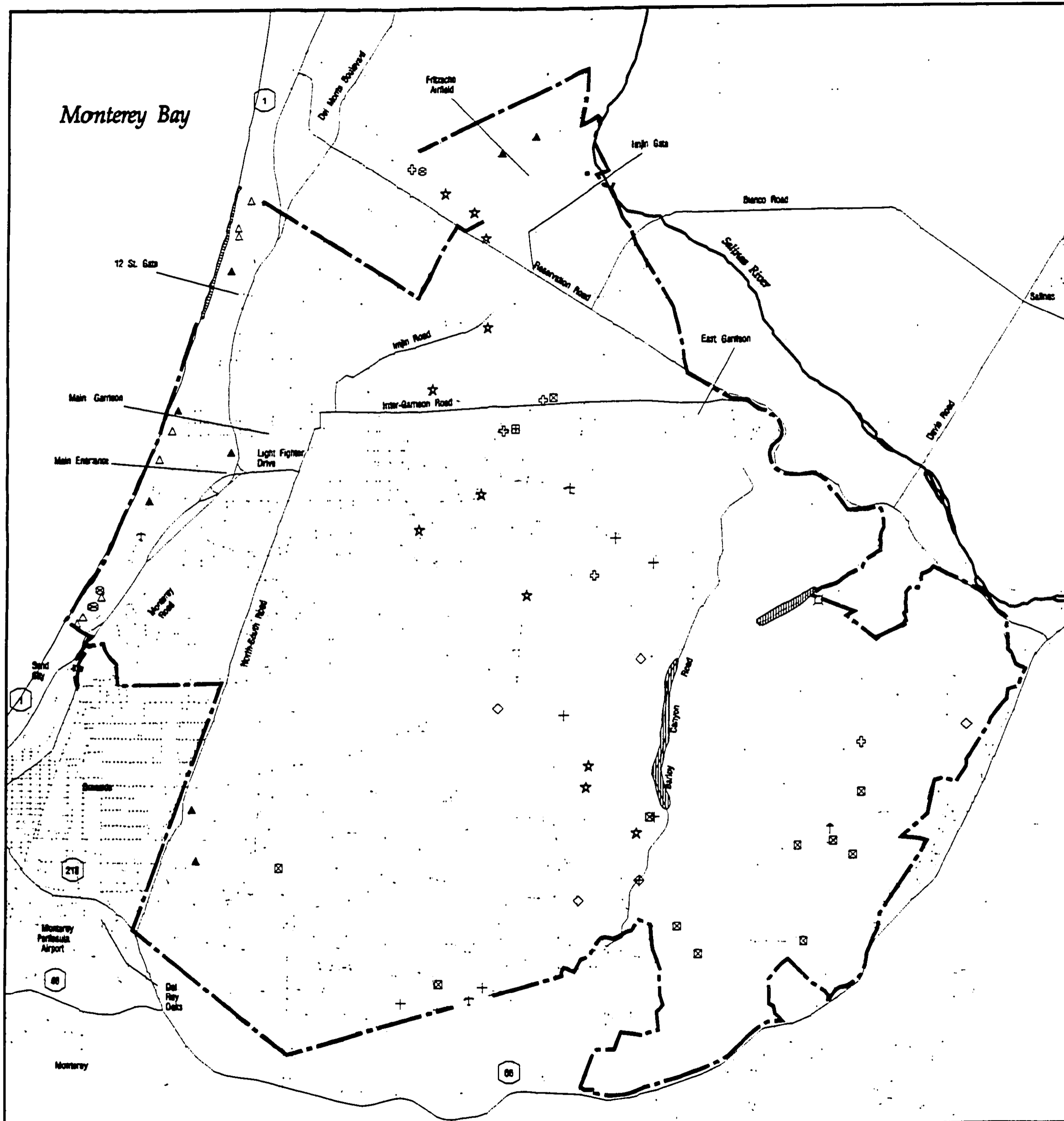
















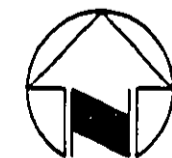
Figure 4.11-11

Known Locations of Special-Status Wildlife Species at Fort Ord

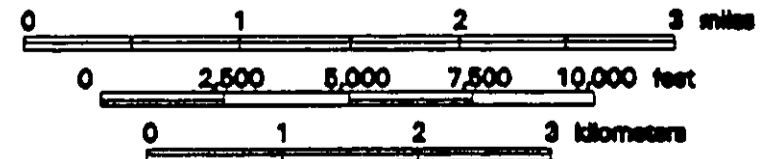
