The Army has determined that no further munitions response is necessary for the County North Munitions Response Area (MRA) covering approximately 500 acres at the former Fort Ord. This area has been identified as a Track 1 area after the Track 1 Record of Decision was signed. Track 1 sites are sites suspected to have been used for military training with military munitions, but no further response action is required based on remedial investigation. Field Investigations of County North identified evidence of past training involving military munitions, but the training involved only the use of practice and pyrotechnic items that are not designed to cause injury. In the unlikely event that an item of the type previously observed at the site is found, it is not expected that the item could be caused to function by casual contact (i.e. inadvertent and unintentional contact).

Consistent with the Track 1 Record of Decision, the Plug-In Approval Memorandum, County North Munitions Response Area (August 2009) was made available for a 30-day public review period that ended on September 28, 2009. The Approval Memorandum contains the rationale for designating this area as Track 1 and that no further munitions response is needed. The Army has received written concurrence from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of California, Department of Toxic Substances Control on the final decision document. This regulatory agency-approved Approval Memorandum serves as the final decision document regarding munitions response for the County North MRA.
