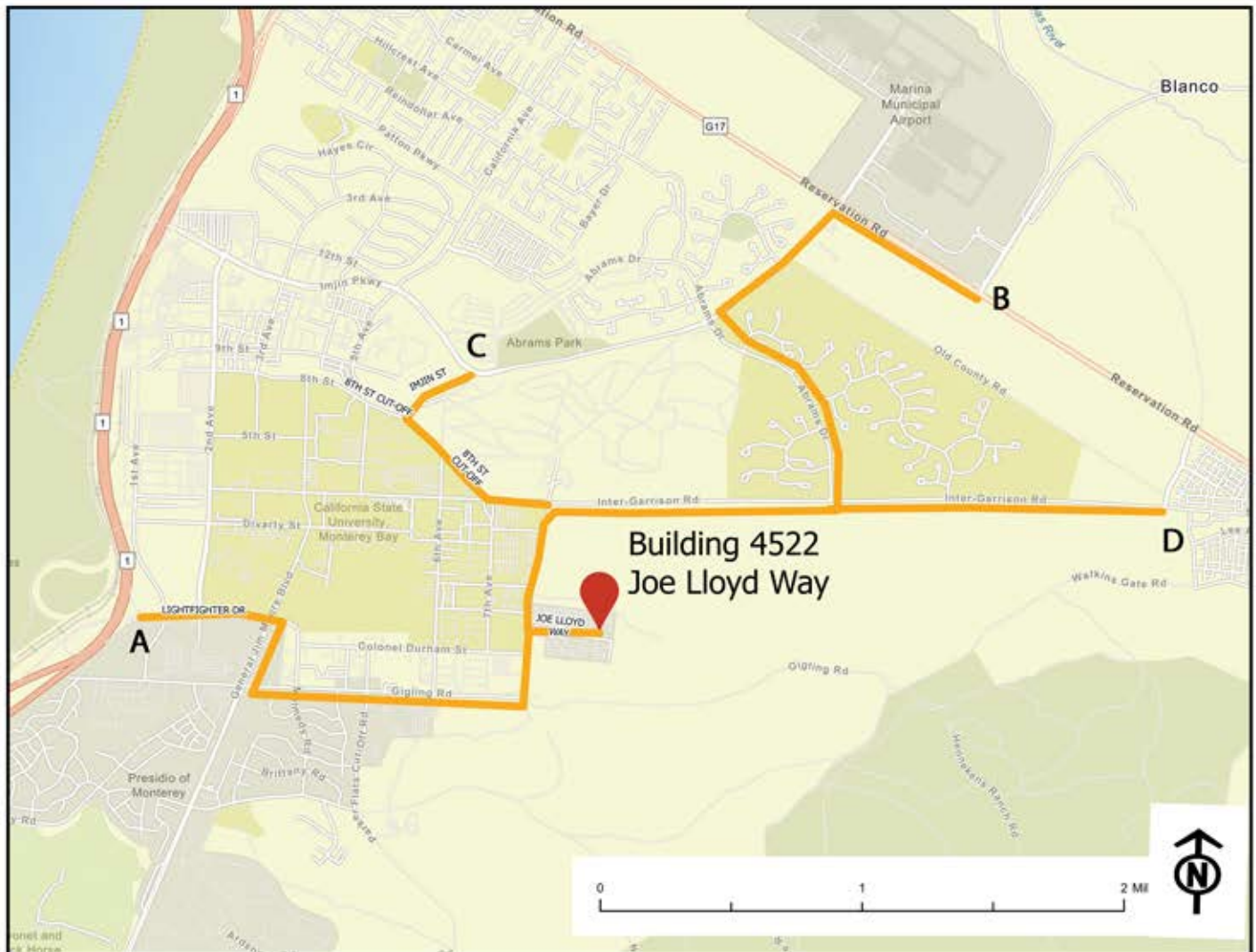

DIRECTIONS TO BUILDING 4522 JOE LLOYD WAY



(A) From Highway 1:

- Exit onto Lightfighter Drive (Exit 406)
- Turn RIGHT onto General Jim Moore Blvd
- Turn LEFT onto Gigling Road
- Turn LEFT onto 8th Avenue
- Turn RIGHT onto Joe Lloyd Way

(C) From Imjin Parkway (Marina):

- Turn onto Imjin Street
- Turn LEFT onto 8th Street Cut Off
- Turn LEFT onto Inter-Garrison Road
- Turn RIGHT onto 8th Avenue
- Turn LEFT onto Joe Lloyd Way

(B) From Reservation Road:

- From Reservation Road (traveling from East to West), turn LEFT onto Imjin Parkway
- Turn LEFT onto Abrams Dr.
- Turn RIGHT onto Inter-Garrison Rd.
- Turn LEFT onto 8th Avenue
- Turn LEFT onto Joe Lloyd Way

(D) From Inter-Garrison (East Garrison):

- Head West on Inter-Garrison Road toward California State University Monterey Bay
- Turn LEFT onto 8th Avenue
- Turn LEFT onto Joe Lloyd Way

Currently there is extensive road construction on Lightfighter Drive and General Jim Moore Blvd. Please drive with caution and obey all traffic signs.
